

Icons next to event information correspond with the event location on the map.

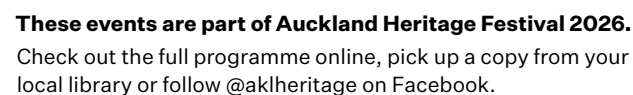

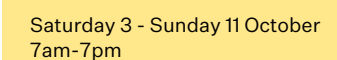

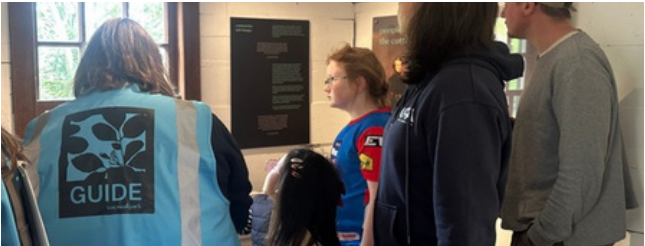


Farm
